


# Korogocho Biodiversity Roadmap


- ✓ Biodiversity is central to many cultures, spiritual beliefs and worldviews.

- Korogocho people make an effort to reduce pollution by managing waste properly. (Aichi Target 4 & 8 & 10 & 15)
- Korogocho people take into account the needs of women, youth, and the poor and vulnerable. (Aichi Target 4 & 14)
- Korogocho people respect traditional knowledge, innovations and practices for Biodiversity. (Aichi Target 1 & 2 & 18)
